

MISSION STATEMENT:

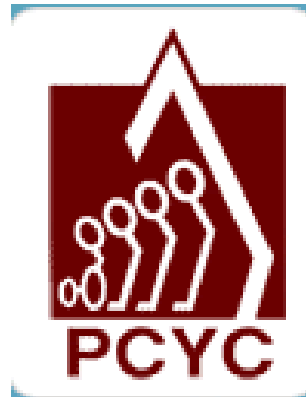
We aim to prepare:

Before School Care

Before School Care begins at 7am and ends at 8.45am. The costs per child for Before School Care for parents paying via Ezidebit is \$12.00. For parents paying by cash or eftpos the cost is \$14.

This time includes breakfast and organized activities that are supervised by staff members of the PCYC community.

The Before School Care mornings consist of quiet Activities, where the children can be in a safe environment.

The staff that work there will provide breakfast for the children attending and will provide constant supervision. If there are any food allergies it is necessary that this is outlined.

After School Care

After School Care Begins at 2:45pm and ends at 6pm. The cost per child for After School Care for parents paying via Ezidebit is \$16. For parents paying using cash or eftpos the cost is \$18.

This time is also supervised by PCYC staff members of the PCYC community. This includes afternoon tea.

The After School Care afternoons consist of structured activities organised by the staff. Some of these activities are cooking, arts and crafts and group games.

The staff that work there will provide afternoon tea for the children attending and will provide constant supervision. If there are any food allergies it is necessary that this is outlined.

To Attend PCYC Outside School Hours Care (OSHC) you must:

- Complete the **family and child enrolment forms**. A child enrolment form must be completed for each child attending OSHC.
- Provide **customer reference numbers** provided by Centrelink. These are a family CRN and child CRN. Please Note: The family CRN and child CRN are separate numbers.
- Be a **member of the PCYC**. Membership costs are \$20.00 per child or a family membership of \$60.00. This membership is current for a calendar year and must be renewed at the end of the year.
- **Pay the enrolment fee of \$120** before your child's commencement at the service.
- **Stay a week ahead in payments**. All families must be a week ahead in payments to the service.
